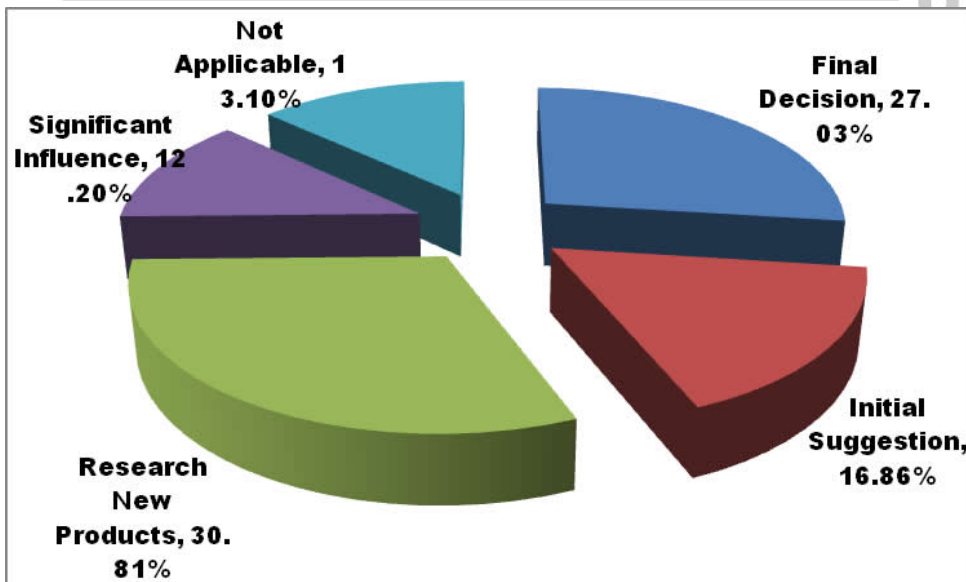

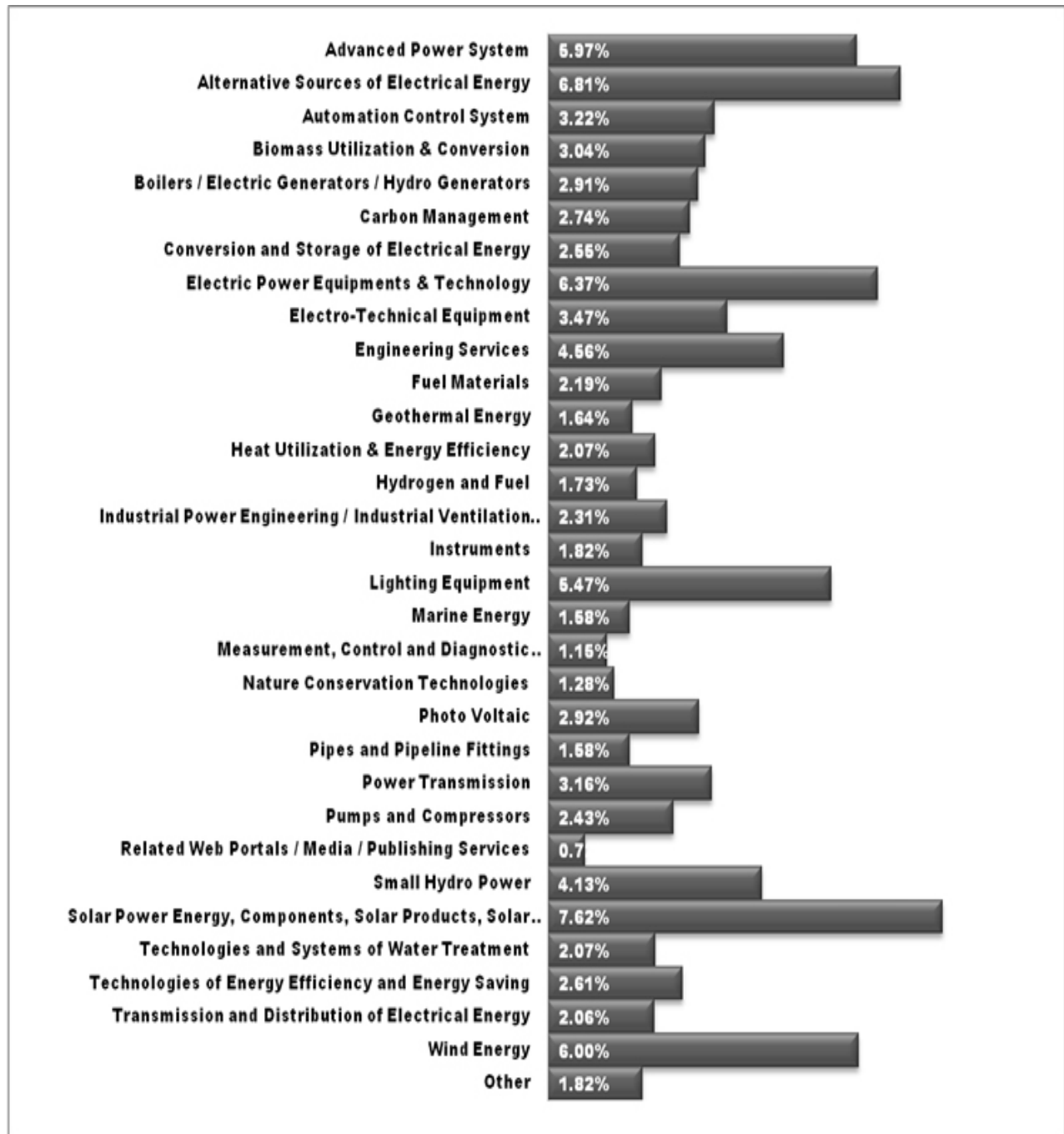

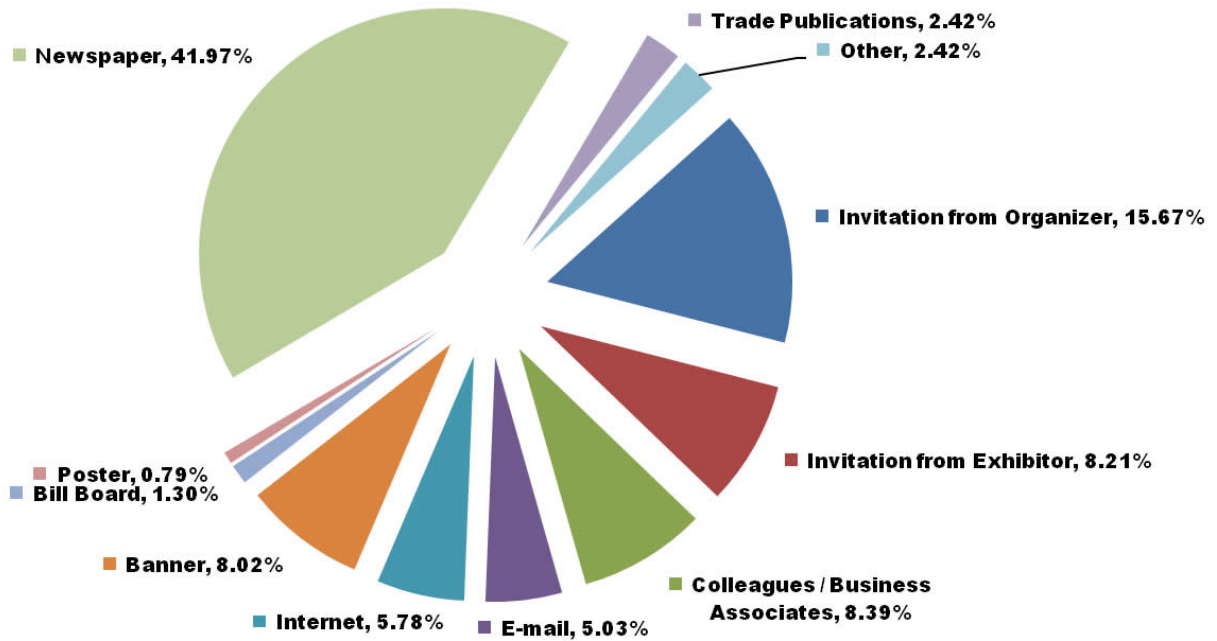

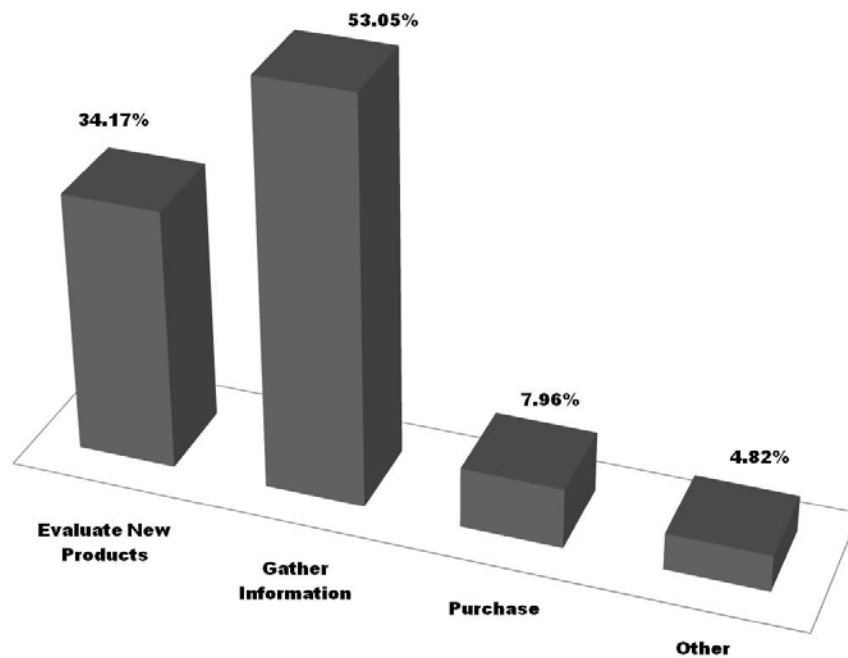


How did '2<sup>nd</sup> POWER Sri Lanka 2010' reach out to the people :
